Dr. Nekola introduced to the audience macroecology and the closely related fields of community ecology and biogeography in a very didactic manner. He focused on the issue of pattern universality from the perspective of statistical mechanics and complex systems. Over the talk he asked several provocative and spot on question to be answered. Scientists invariably search for mechanism to explain pattern using mechanism from within their given discipline. This approach, however, is sensible given that we know most about those subjects within our respective fields. But what happens when the patterns we wish to understand are found to be universal expectations across a number of seemingly unrelated fields? Does limiting ourselves to disciplinary mechanisms make sense in such situations? We ended up with some important suggestions and rationalization how we can progress forward. This one hour talk stimulated an extensive and vital discussion as the talk received more than a hundred participants.
