Become an excellent graduate = DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

- Your research project (→ new findings → publications)
 - → thesis/defence
 - Quality publications (Q1/Q2) are important in contemporary science, they are important for you (career) and also for us (SCI MUNI)

Theoretical skills

Take courses at MU or outside, participate in webinars, summer schools,

Practical skills – learn by doing, network, mentoring by your peers

Data and statistics

International experiences – obligatory stay abroad: MOBILITY


Teaching and supervising skills – for your future academic career

Write grant project proposal

Write publications

Present your research to scientists (posters/lectures)

Communicate your science to laymen – show the relevancy and importance to the society Keep up to date with science e.g. EOSC / OPEN SCIENCE / publishing practices (MDPI?)





Our expectations

- Together with you, we want to reach a common goal = ADVANCING
 SCIENCE FOR THE GOOD of people, society, planet...
- You have just 4 years to become a DOCTOR OF SCIENCE: use the time and benefit as much as possible from this limited opportunity
 - ... and then be ready to move forward elsewhere to learn more (postdoc)
 - ... and you can eventually compete in the future to come back to SCI MUNI
- PhD is a win-win "contract" between student and the institution.
 - We (faculty, department, supervisor) offer facilities, training and mentoring, financing
 - You offer your capacities (brain and hands), motivation
 - Your PhD topic and all financing (scholarhips, part-time contract) should be aligned and synergized
- Going for PhD is your decision in your life and career and the success is your responsibility
 - we will do our best to support you within the framework of the "contract" but we also need to know your needs: have your voice, raise your doubts or demands






REGARDING MOBILITIES

- PhD is your decision in your life and career ...
 - Your future success also depends on your international partners, network and it depends on your mobility abroad (which is now obligatory for min 1 month, btw)
- Your responsibility is to plan and seek for the most relevant stay abroad
 - ... relevant to your research and topic, bringing new skills
 - pro-actively apply for travel grants / conference scholarships etc.
- We will support you (faculty, department, supervisors)
 - Identification and contacting partners abroad
 - Financial support (e.g. additional scholarships)
 - Administration
- but within our "contractual" framework, i.e. "win-win" for you and SCI MUNI
 - Travel to strategic partners of your supervisor / department long-term partnerships
 - Travel to best universities (so you really learn from the best)
 - Follow the rules and procedures
